Dear Business Clients & Guests,

In light of the rapidly evolving situation related to the COVID-19 (aka coronavirus), the Tampa Convention Center (TCC) has taken several proactive steps to ensure the safety of visitors to our venue. Drawing from the recommendations and guidance promulgated by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Florida Department of Health, TCC has implemented the following enhanced initiatives and facility cleaning and personal hygiene practices:

- TCC maintains a nearly 100% touch-free entry/exit and bathroom user experience for our visitors.
 TCC has five automatic double-door main entry points providing touch-free entry and exit from the building and two automatic double-door proximity card protected entry points to the kitchen service corridors;
- 2. TCC has deployed a multi-member "touch-points" cleaning task force to clean all public touch points in the main building on an hourly or more frequent schedule. Touch points include door handles, all handrails, all bathroom surfaces, all tables and chairs in the meeting rooms, exposition halls and café areas, all elevator surfaces to include call buttons on all landings as well as interior elevator surfaces. TCC is using safe and effective germicidal & virucidal cleaners and disinfectant solutions for this purpose;
- 3. TCC has increased the frequency of refilling all bathroom soap dispensers and towel dispensers in preparation for higher than average use of these hand hygiene items;
- 4. TCC has deployed six new touch-free portable hand sanitizing stations using the CDC recommended alcohol based liquid hand sanitizer;

5. TCC employees and our partner employees have been provided with awareness products for proper hand washing techniques as well as proper cough and sneeze etiquette;

6. Any TCC or partner staff displaying signs or symptoms of sickness will be required to remain home;

7. We have placed coronavirus awareness and enhanced personal hygiene guidance messaging posters in public and employee service areas throughout the Center.
