START HERE — EVERY FOREIGN TEAM, EVERY TIME

Complete the [2026–27 USA Volleyball Foreign Team Summary Form online](#). Nothing else can move forward until this is done. **Team insurance and administrative fees are mandatory for all foreign teams and are paid inside this form** — there is no separate payment step and no exceptions.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS BY TEAM TYPE

	CANADIAN TEAMS	ALL NON-CANADIAN FOREIGN TEAMS
PLAYERS	- Valid USAV-issued membership, assigned to the club - Listed on the Letter of Good Standing roster	- Listed on the Letter of Good Standing roster MANDATORY UPLOAD: Signed Individual Registration Form — one per player <i>Optional upload: Proof of age</i> — government-issued (passport, driver's license, birth certificate) must be onsite at event.
COACHES	- Valid USAV-issued membership, assigned to the club - Listed on the Letter of Good Standing roster - USAV staff must Manually approve this membership once the LOGS is uploaded	- Listed on the Letter of Good Standing roster - Signed Individual Registration Form - Parent/guardian AND player signatures are required on ALL pages.
MEMBER-SHIP INFO	Approval email delivers a club code + club assignment link — save it. Coaches and Players use the link to obtain their membership.	No USAV membership required. Upload all mandatory documents and Confirm clearance on the Foreign Teams Approval Page before the team competes.

WHO DOES WHAT

Foreign Teams & Clubs	Event Directors
- Complete the Foreign Team Summary Form and pay team insurance. - Watch for the approval email. Canadian teams: it contains your club code and club assignment link. - Register for the USAV-sanctioned event (if not already registered), then roster players in the event system. - Upload your Letter of Good Standing in SportsEngine: log in, open Registrations, pick the registration, then click the pencil icon to edit and upload. For help uploading your documents go HERE. Then notify your event director that this requirement is complete. - Check the Foreign Teams Approval Page for participation approval.	- Send registering foreign teams to the Foreign Team Summary Form — <i>This is a mandatory step to compete at ANY USAV event.</i> - Confirm insurance and Letter of Good Standing approval on the universal Foreign Team Approval Page. - Download and review mandatory uploads/information (ONLY for non-Canadian Teams) on the Foreign Teams Info Page. <i>This page contains personal information and is locked to Event Directors ONLY (permission granted through the Event Directors Page Access Form)</i> - Approve the team and assist with rostering if needed.
